
May this Easter remind us to take a stand in living for Christ. You might feel like you are taking a long shot, but God is using your life for something grand and bold in Christ!





Since the fall of communism, Romania has been putting itself back together. However, there is still significant government corruption, a lack of trust, and skepticism that hard work, courage, and perseverance can pay off.

We have been called to work with Roma youth in the Jiu Valley to build trust, perseverance, character, and courage through rock climbing. Roma people are heavily discriminated against. And Dallas, the neighborhood closest to our gym, is one of the poorest in the valley.

Many parents move away to find work but leave their children behind in Dallas. These children receive little education and have to beg or steal to make ends meet. Our ministry provides youth in Dallas with an environment where they can experience safety and respect, develop life skills and character, pursue education, and come to know the love of Christ.

We work in partnership with the New Horizons Foundation.

Maundy Thursday is the Thursday before Easter, believed to be the day when Jesus celebrated his final Passover with His disciples. What does Maundy Thursday Mean? Christ's "mandate" is commemorated on Maundy Thursday---"maundy" being a shortened form of mandatum (Latin), which means "command." It was on the Thursday of

Christ's final week before being crucified and resurrected that He said these words to his disciples: "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another." John 13:34



### A quick summary of our Phase 2— Sanctuary Renovation Project

On November 11, 2018 the congregation approved an approximate cost of a \$600,000 renovation of the sanctuary. The financing of this project will be accomplished by a \$365,000 gift of the Veldhuizen gift to the Building fund and \$8,792 from the Vande Krol annuity. \$50,291 was applied from the current balance (at this time) from our Building Fund, leaving \$175,917 as an outstanding balance on the remaining project. We will be using funds from the General church account (\$175,917) to pay down the difference until funds are raised through our Building fund to pay back the General account (hence, borrowing from ourselves).
