A biblical definition of coincidence could be "what occurs together by God's providential arrangement of circumstances."

What appears to us as random circumstances could actually be God orchestrating a seemingly small event or happening.

Several years ago Pastor Wayne was looking for wood to make a cross to be used at the front of the church during the Easter season and mentioned this to Jeff Van Wyk.


