It was approved by the consistory to pave the north parking lot. Bids have been approved as follows—concrete—\$174,814, grading work—\$4,500 and painting parking lines \$1,800. Construction is tentative to begin following September 10 and the processing of getting permits. The funds will be taken from the recent gift from the Leo Vande Krol estate. This improvement to our church facilities is not part of our Phase 2 building project.
