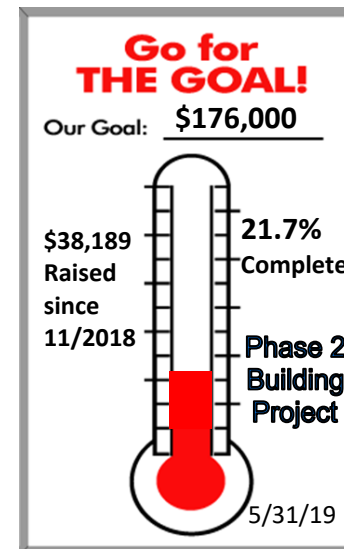


◆ **FAITHWALKERS PANCAKE BREAKFAST:** Thursday, July 4, 7—9:30 am at the Sully Community Building.
