



Consistory Notes—June 19, 2019

Our meeting opened with prayer and scripture. The elders shared the following:

- Communion will be celebrated on Sunday, June 30.
- Paul & Patty Sneller were received as communicant members by letter of transfer from the Central Reformed Church of Sioux Center, Iowa. They live near Montezuma.
- The baptism of Siara Dunsbergen, daughter of Andy and Jamie Dunsbergen was approved. Baptism date scheduled is July 7, 2019.
- The baptism of Sadie Zimmerman, daughter of Derrick and Annette Zimmerman was approved. Baptism date scheduled is June 30, 2019.

The deacons shared:

- May giving: General Fund—\$27,459.25; Mission—\$7,781; Sunday School—\$132.84; Building—\$4,701.64. The General Fund Balance is \$67,516.92 and the Mission Fund Balance is \$20,446.26.
- Distributions for Mission causes shared were: \$500 to assist a benevolence need; \$2,000 to Faithwalkers (our Senior High Youth Group) for 2019 Mission Trip; \$1000 to our VBS expenses; \$100 to Smoke on the Water; \$50 to Lynnville Sully Ministerial Fund.
- Designated Labor Day offerings: 1/2 Mission Fund, 1/4 Words of Hope and 1/4 Gideons International.
- Information: Memorial Day offering was \$6,181.

Full consistory:

- Howard De Penning and Gene Jansen completed building the stage area in the Gathering Place in preparation for worship services to be held here beginning July 7.
- Old Business included approving the engraving of the headstone of Wilma Veldhuizen as a show of courtesy for the estate Wilma gave to the church. She has no close living relatives. Cost is \$130.
- New Business included sharing that we are in charge of the 4th of July service at the park for the community on July 7 at 6:00 pm. We are partnering with the Friends Church of Lynnville. A youth choir from Clarkston, Georgia (a mission that we support via the Zagami's) will be singing for the service.

• General Synod 2019 was reviewed. A decision for the future of the RCA will be announced at the 2020 General Synod.

Phase 2 Report

- June 30 a Building offering will be taken.
- It was shared that 36 out of 40 pews were spoken for via a bid response. \$1900 was raised for the Building Fund. Those who submitted bids will be contacted. Pews will be removed on July 1, 2019.
- Committee assignments for worship services in the Gathering Place were reviewed.
- A report from the Phase 2 Building Committee is as follows: We have gotten the bids back and selected a contractor. Eick & Day Construction from Johnston is the contractor. They came in a little under the construction estimate. We have added a hearing loop for roughly \$30,000. We are also working with a new AV contractor as the old one dropped out. That bid has not come back yet, but it will be higher, partially due to 25% tariffs on much of the equipment. We still plan to remove pews and other items on July 1st and moving the organ later that week.
- A memorial gift of \$3,658 to the Building Fund Phase 2 Project in memory of Verla Jansen was acknowledged.
