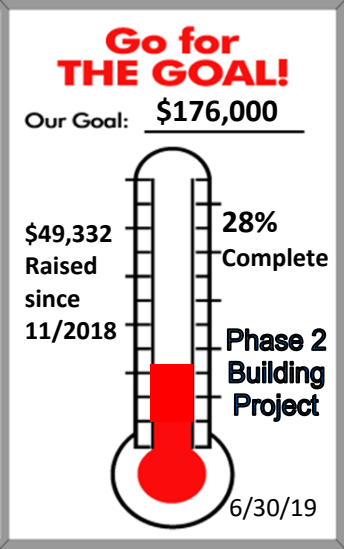

## "Partnering with the God of History"

Exodus 1:8-13, 22; Exodus 2:1-10

July 14, 2019

In 1776, the United States fell in bondage to Great Britain. Today, 244 years later, many in our nation find themselves slipping into bondage again. (The bondage of selfishness, and greed, and personal pleasure).

1. Our God works against all bondage to bring \_\_\_\_\_ under Himself.
2. The God of history was at work with His everlasting purpose of saving His people from bondage in \_\_\_\_\_.

3. Amram and Jochebed remembered they belonged to God and believed God was in \_\_\_\_\_ even in the darkest hours.

Point 1: God was and is in control as the God of History.

Point 2: Therefore, refuse to quit and instead partner with God.

### LEARNINGS:

First: When days look \_\_\_\_\_ God is at work to save His people, for God is the God of history and works through history.

### APPLICATIONS

1. Foster a firm resolve that to our dying day we will never quit.
2. Remember, all things are possible with God.
3. Remember, we are not here by chance. We're given life and talents by the very hand of God to use for Him as we fulfill His purposes for us.
4. God called Sully Reformed Church here to be of service to Him and a witness to the grace of God at this time and in this place.
5. Remember, our nation didn't happen by chance. Our Forefather's saw God at work and rooted their faith in Him.

**DINNER TABLE DISCUSSION:** How has God worked in our history to bring our family to today---and what might God be willing and wanting to do in our present as we work with the God of history to make a difference?

ANSWERS: freedom, Egypt, control, darkest, stop, faith, forsake.
