

- **1.** In the Greek, John 2:23 is literally saying that: "Although many trusted in Him (Jesus), He did not trust in them!" Why not?
- **2.** Why is it a good thing that God is never fooled to think that anybody is all good & wonderful & deserving of heaven?
- **3.** Would you agree that it is utterly amazing that God loves you in spite of your sins and has proved it by having Christ die for you?
- **4.** What is the first step in the rehabilitation of anyone?
- **5.** Would you agree with Jesus that all people need a new birth?
- **6.** Jesus says: "Unless a man is born of water and the spirit he cannot enter the Kingdom of God." To what does the water refer? Does Ephesians 5:26 help us to understand as it says that Christ gave himself for the Church: "That He might cleanse it with the washing of water by the Word."
- **7.** Have you experienced that God has worked in you through His Spirit so you have come to believe? Since then, have you begun to see any evidence of God working to start a new life growing in you?
- **8.** Jesus was disappointed with Nicodemus's failure to believe that new birth is real on the basis of its' observable effects on transformed lives. Where have you seen or known lives transformed by the power of the Gospel?
- **9.** We rightly thrill to hear and know; of so many people's lives transformed by Christ. Would you agree that it is equally wonderful to grow up knowing Christ and then never rebel and nearly ruin our lives? Is this also evidence of the power of Christ at work in us to maintain and sustain our new life?
- **10.** Have you opened your heart to Christ and invited Him to come in and give you a new birth and a new life? If not, now is the time. Just pray something like this: "I believe in you Jesus and I invite you to come into my life and give me the gift of this new birth and a whole new beginning in you."
