In this story of Daniel, we will be looking at eight things Daniel did when he was faced with an impossible assignment. Today, we will look at three of Daniel’s actions.

Before we look at how Daniel handled the problem of interpreting King Nebuchadnezzar’s dream, I want you to know three things about what God says about predicting the future.

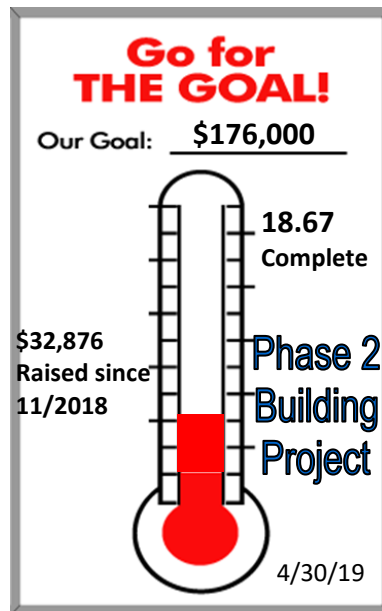
