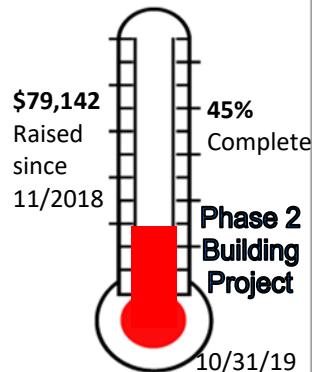


PHASE 2 PROJECT is coming along right on schedule. The AV equipment continues to be installed! The sanctuary lights are finished and were picked up this weekend.
