

Consistory Notes - October 16, 2019

Our meeting opened with prayer and devotions led by Kurt Harthoorn. **The elders shared that:**

- Nick and Hannah De Penning made their profession of faith in Jesus Christ and were received as communicant members of First Reformed.
- A report on the fall Classis meeting held on September 26 at Central College was shared. Pastor Wayne, Chuck Johnson and Teryl Ver Ploeg were our representatives.

- Care and communion assignments were reviewed.
- Anchor service status report by Jeff Knouse: In regard to Anchor, the ministry is currently taking a pause from its monthly services. Because of this we have put a pause on monthly services.
