Consistory Notes

September 16, 2020

The meeting opened with prayer and scripture with our topic being the importance of investing yourself in someone and encouraging them in the faith.

The baptismal request of Tyler and Ryanne Jansen for their son Cam Edward Jansen was approved. The date requested was October 25.

World Wide Communion will be held October 4, 2020.

There will not be a CROP walk this year due to COVID-19. We will still be given the opportunity to give to this mission for feeding the hungry by supporting our local food pantries and beyond.

Pastor Wayne, Teryl Ver Ploeg and Craig Maasdam will be our delegates to the fall classis meeting at Prairie City on September 24.

The deacons shared:

- That \$15,000 was moved from the Kaldenberg fund to the General Fund to pay for the church windows and the parsonage air conditioner.
- The Thanksgiving offering will be designated to the Mission Fund.
- It was approved to purchase a new Four Square in the Air game for the youth.
- \$2,500 from the Mission Fund will be designated to Samaritan's Purse to help with damage from the derecho storm.
- The purchase of office chairs for the office, pastor's study, bookkeepers/ children's ministry director and youth director's office was approved at a cost of up to \$5,200. Money will be taken from the Kaldenberg fund.
- August offerings: General \$27,554.25; Mission \$1,025.84; Labor Day offering \$3,172.50; General Fund balance \$25,082.12; Mission Fund balance \$19,253.69.

A time was spent reviewing our church family's spiritual and physical needs. We have had many marriages, deaths and sick and shut-ins this month.

Committee reports:

- It was approved to allow the usage of the Well for 4-H Clover kids once a month.
- Interchurch relations committee reported that our recent Rededication Service offering was \$2,410 and \$800 expenses.
- Church usher business included revamped in person worship guidelines.
- The main sanctuary will return to normal worship seating. The east wing will be designated seating for those wishing to practice social distancing

in worship. Our goal is to respond to our increased worship attendance and have also a safe worship experience as well in our COVID-19 world.

• We will return to coffee time served from the kitchen after the morning service beginning September 20. Details will be in the bulletin.

New business:

- Approval of our nominations of elder and deacon slate. Our congregational meeting will be held Sunday, November 8.
- We were recently notified by lawyers of the estate of Wilma Rozendaal that the church will receive 1/10 of her estate.
- Volunteer teachers and youth leaders were approved. God is good!
