Consistory Notes - September 11, 2019

Our meeting opened with prayer and devotions led by Chuck Johnson and Pastor Wayne.

The elders shared the following:

- The baptism request for Brooks Henkle was approved. He is the son of Cole and Kayla Henkle.
- The request to join church by letter of transfer by Dave Winegar from the Prairie City Christian Reformed Church was approved.
- Central Iowa Classis will be held at Central College on September 26, 2019.
 Elders Chuck Johnson and Teryl Ver Ploeg as well as Pastor Wayne Sneller will be attending.
- A follow up report on Northwestern College and Kurt Korver's letter published in the paper was shared. Pastor Wayne will write a letter to Northwestern's President Greg Christy urging the college to stay true to Biblical values and the authority of scripture when teaching creation.
 World Wide Communion will be held on October 6, 2019.

The deacons shared:

- General Fund Balance: \$49,566.43; Mission Fund: \$13,800.09; August giving
 General: \$30,436.82; Mission: \$1030.00; Building: \$3,246.
- Information: Labor Day offering \$3,711. Hunger (CROP) Walk is Sunday, September 29 at 5:00 pm; Wilda Nikkel's memorial of \$505 was deposited in the Building Fund.
- The East wing roof of the church was reshingled at a cost of \$10,200 (this was under the submitted bid of \$12,000, contractors were Bruce Dunsbergen Builders).

Full Consistory

- · Care teams and needs of our congregation were shared.
- Discussion and review on the third draft of our Safety Policy Handbook was done. Additional work will be made on this draft. A fourth draft with completed suggestions will be brought before full consistory for approval at our next meeting.
- The initial nomination slate for elder and deacon was submitted to consistory and approved. Contact with perspective nominees will be done in the coming weeks.
- Rev. Carl Boersma, Central Iowa Classis pastor, was with us to explain the Commissioned Pastor Program to the consistory. This was done as Jeff Knouse, our Youth Director, has informed the consistory of his intent to enroll in the Commissioned Pastor's Program in Central Iowa Classis. We will continue the consistory's process of this by further study and discussion at our next consistory meeting.
- Pastor Wayne will take his Education week on October 7 12; November 3 6 (November 3 will be the Study leave Sunday as he was called back from his study leave for a funeral earlier in the year).
- Phase 2 continues on schedule as we are in the painting phase.


